APPLICATION PROCEDURE

2018-2019 Season

Violin I and Violin II (SECTION)

In order to schedule an audition, qualified candidates must send a one-page résumé along with a fifty (\$50.00) dollar deposit (check payable to ASO) to:
Allentown Symphony, 23 N. 6th Street, Allentown, PA 18101

Deposit must be received by August 29, 2018.

The **Fifty-Dollar \$50.00 deposit** will be returned to the candidate upon completion of the audition. No one will be scheduled for an audition without a deposit. No refunds for no-shows or for cancellations for any reason whatsoever after August 31, 2018, one week prior to the audition date of THURSDAY, September 6, 2018.

REQUIREMENTS: Prepare a movement from a concerto of your choice plus excerpts from the pre-determined repertoire list for **SECTION ONLY (NOT Concertmaster or Assistant Principal, etc.)** and possible sight-reading. Required excerpts are posted on the ASO website at allentownsymphony.org. In order to schedule an audition, candidates must not be subject to any visa or immigration status that would prevent lawful employment.

SECTION PAY

\$104.86 for rehearsals of no more than two and one-half (2 ½) hours.
\$114.70 for rehearsals of more than 2 ½ hours but not more than 3 hours.
\$110.37 for concerts + Travel

Travel Round Trip per Service Rate. Those residing outside a twenty (20) mile radius of the service site at \$.43 per mile. (A round trip mileage compensation deduction of forty (40) miles. Mileage Cap is 136 miles per round trip.) Max \$58.48.
